6th Class – Chloe, Sean and Kristen.



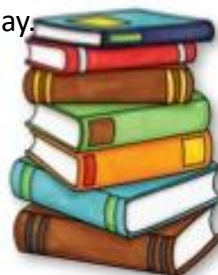
Hosanna Rock and Countdown to Christmas!

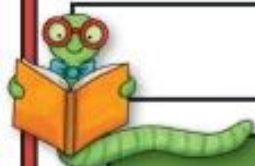
